

# THE ENGLISH ALPHABET

The English alphabet is composed of 26 letters:

You may need to use the names of the letters to spell names or abbreviations. For example:

- My name's Esperanza, E-S-P-E-R-A-N-Z-A ([i:]-[ɛs]-[pi:]-[i:]-[ɑr]-[eɪ]-[ɛn]-[zɛd]-[eɪ]).
- I studied at the IOC ([aɪ]-[oʊ]-[si:]).
- He became the CEO ([si:]-[i:]-[oʊ]).
